Since 1994 (Warsaw, Poland), every second year, the seminar has been organized as a general forum for

exchange of information about progress in aerospace engineering research. The unique character of the seminar is given by its focus also on aircraft engineering education and inclusion of juried student session.

Over the years, the seminar has travelled from Warsaw (Poland), through Vilnius (Lithuania), Riga (Latvia) to Tartu (Estonia), Brno (Czech Republic), then to Warsaw, Brno, Vilnius, Warsaw, Brno and this year arrives to Rzeszow (Poland).



EWDAE - history overview

The first European Workshop on Aircraft Design Education was held in Madrid in 1994. Further workshops were organized every two years traveling through many countries. Since 2002 the abbreviation EWADE is in use. Many scientists from EWADE participated at RRDPAE 2008 in Brno where the idea of a stronger cooperation was discussed. Finally in 2018, EWADE joined the READ conference in Brno and will do so again this year in Rzeszów.

EWDAE is one of the two partner organizations who started the Technical Committee Aircraft Design (TCAD) under CEAS in 2013.
